## **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

Develop and implement manufacturing business improvement projects and processes for trailer manufacturing. Support teams to make improvements to existing devices and manufacturing processes. Lead complex projects independently with minimal supervision.

- Apply technical knowledge to innovate, design, and develop processes, procedures, and tooling.
- Develop, execute, and follow through, utilizing effective project management plans, which clearly identify the scope, timelines, and resources for key project activities.
- Plan, organize, and conduct all aspects of technical reviews.
- Ensure proper documentation is completed to meet quality systems requirements.
- Oversee development builds associated with the project using special work requests.
- Develop and maintain qualified production lines.
- Provide Design for Manufacturability (DFM) input to the engineering print package.
- Contribute or generate ideas.
- Train and/or provide work direction to technicians and engineers and may train manufacturing personnel when required as part of a validation.
- May serve as a core team member or extended team member on new product projects.

- Participate in lean reviews and line side meetings.
- Must comply with requirements of Environmental, Health and Safety standards and follow procedures and instructions related to these standards.
- Establish and support a work environment of continuous improvement that supports Quality Policy, Quality System and the appropriate regulations for the area they support. Ensure employees are trained to do their work and their training is documented.
